Hello one and all

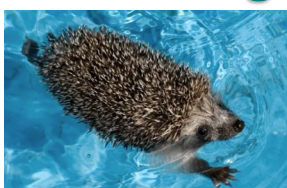

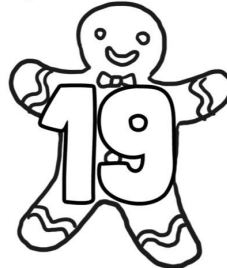

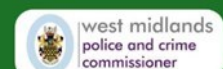
Online safety is when young people know who they can tell if they feel upset by something that has happened online.
