## **OVERVIEW**

This policy is intended to ensure consistency across the school in terms of home learning practice.

## **OBJECTIVES**

- To encourage children to develop organisational skills and self- discipline
- To bridge the gap between home and school and to provide parents and carers with direct involvement in children's learning
- To develop children's independent learning skills
- To personalise learning and develop children's self-motivation and self-confidence

## **HOMEWORK ACTIVITIES AND EXPECTATIONS ACROSS THE SCHOOL**

**All homework will be set in the red Homework books unless otherwise stated.**

- Reading 5 times per week (recorded in the home-school book)
- Spelling practice in homework book
- Weekly Maths activities to consolidate learning carried out in the previous week at school.
- Weekly English activities linked to the topics being covered in English lessons
- There may be some additional activities provided linked to topic work being carried out in class, but this will not be weekly.

## **HOMEWORK TIMINGS**

### **Math and English**

Set and sent home on Mondays. Hand in on Fridays.

### **Topic**

Set and sent home on Wednesdays. Hand in on Tuesdays.

### **Spellings**

Set and sent home on Fridays. Hand in on Thursdays.

### **Reading books**

Sent home every day.



### **FURTHER INFORMATION**

The home-school book should be brought into school daily with reading completed at home recorded by an adult. This can also be used to communicate any questions/queries/notes for class teachers or other school staff.

Teachers will award merits for homework completed to a high standard and handed in on time.
