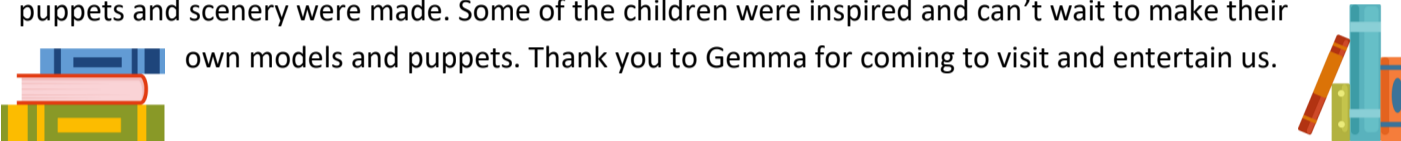
STORYTELLING
